Child Protection Policy

1. Introduction

EDGE Worldwide Limited is committed to the safety, well-being, and dignity of all children and young people with whom we engage. This policy outlines EDGE Worldwide Limited 's approach to preventing and responding to child abuse, neglect, and exploitation.

2. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to:

- Establish a framework for safeguarding children.
- Ensure all EDGE Worldwide Limited staff, volunteers, and partners understand their responsibilities.
- Provide clear guidelines for preventing and responding to child protection concerns.

3. Scope

This policy applies to all EDGE Worldwide Limited employees, volunteers, contractors, and any individuals or organizations representing or collaborating with EDGE Worldwide Limited in Cambodia and elsewhere.

4. Definitions

Child: Any person under the age of 18.

Child Abuse: Physical, emotional, sexual abuse, neglect, exploitation, or exposure to harm.

Exploitation: Using a child for personal or commercial gain.

5. Commitment to Child Protection

EDGE Worldwide Limited is committed to:

- Creating a child-safe environment.
- Preventing harm through education and risk management.
- Responding appropriately to allegations or concerns.
- Complying with local and international child protection laws.

6. Code of Conduct

All EDGE Worldwide Limited personnel must:

- Treat children with respect and dignity.
- Never engage in inappropriate physical or verbal interactions.
- Avoid situations where they are alone with a child.
- · Report any concerns about child safety immediately.

7. Recruitment and Training

- All staff and volunteers undergo background checks before engagement.
- Mandatory child protection training is provided.
- Clear expectations regarding child safeguarding are communicated.

8. Reporting and Response

- Any suspicion or allegation of child abuse must be reported to the designated Child Protection Officer (CPO) immediately.
- Confidentiality will be maintained to protect all parties.
- EDGE will work with relevant authorities to investigate and respond to concerns.

9. Risk Management

- EDGE will conduct regular child protection risk assessments.
- Programs will be designed with child safety as a priority.
- Clear reporting structures will be maintained.

10. Review and Compliance

This policy will be reviewed annually and updated as needed. All EDGE Worldwide Limited personnel are responsible for ensuring compliance with this policy.
